**Islamabad:** Islamic Relief Pakistan Country Director Fadlullah Wilmot stressed the need for strengthening the disaster response system through institutional capacity building for a timely response to deal with major disasters. Wilmot said that we need to strengthen our early warning capacities, especially for droughts and floods, which occurred frequently and had high socioeconomic impact. He said an effective emergency response system was highly imperative for reducing the impact of disasters.

Safer hospitals and schools were vital to disaster risks reduction and for this purpose Islamic Relief is working on the mega construction projects in the flood-affected areas, he maintained. Presently we are construction 60 villages across the country with an integrated approach and providing livelihood solutions to strengthen flood-hit communities, he added. He appreciated IRP Peshawar staff for carrying out a marvelous work for helping the flood affectees.
